## What is this product?

### Type

This product is a share of an investment company qualifying as an undertaking for collective investments in transferable securities (UCITS).

### Objectives

#### Investment objective

The objective of the compartment is to offer investors equity portfolio returns across a business cycle, by investing in stocks and integrating environmental, social and governance ("ESG") considerations, while keeping the volatility in line with the long-term average of the asset class.

### Investment policy

The compartment combines a Top-Down (macroeconomic analysis of geography, market cap allocation and sectors) and Bottom-Up (quantitative and fundamental analysis of stocks and industries) approach, without systematic sector bias. Indicatively, at least 60% of net assets are invested in large/mega-cap stocks, up to 40% in mid-caps, with small caps only ancillary. At least 70% is invested in North American equities. Market cap ranges: Mega Cap > USD 100bn; Large Cap USD 30–100bn; Mid Cap USD 2–30bn; Small Cap < USD 2bn.

Exposure to non-developed markets is residual (max 10%), through direct or indirect investments. Target investments are mainly denominated in USD and EUR, with average USD exposure ~70% (minimum 50%). The compartment may invest up to 10% in eligible UCITS/UCIs (daily liquidity, no leverage) and up to 10% in short-term U.S. government bonds (<12 months). ADRs and GDRs are also permitted.

On an ancillary basis, the compartment may invest in short-term liquid instruments (bonds <12 months, money market funds/instruments, listed assets). It may also hold up to 20% in liquid assets (cash, deposits) for operations, pending investments or adverse market conditions, with temporary excesses allowed in exceptional circumstances, in the best interests of investors.

### Intended Investors

This share class is intended for investors who are interested in achieving a net positive performance, can afford to set aside their capital for at least 3 years, are willing and able to accept meaningful temporary losses, and have experience with the risks and rewards of investing in equities.

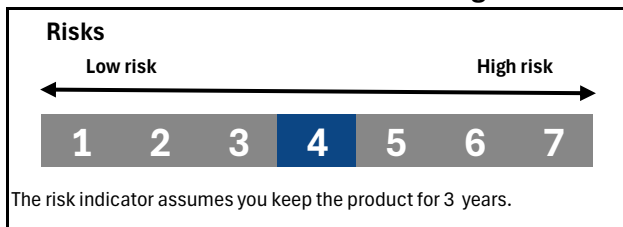
**Class type:** this class is a capitalization class, meaning that income is reinvested.

**Conversion right:** the investor has the right to convert his investment in shares in one sub-fund for shares in the same sub-fund or in another sub-fund. The investor can obtain information about how to convert in the prospectus of the fund.

**Segregation:** the assets and liabilities of a sub-fund are segregated pursuant to the law so that the commitments and liabilities of one sub-fund do not affect the other sub-funds.

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is medium. In other words, the potential losses linked to future performance are at medium level and, if the market situation were to deteriorate, the ability of AISM Luxembourg S.A. to make payments could be adversely affected.

**Be aware of currency risk.** The amounts you will receive will be denominated in a different currency, so the final return you obtain will depend on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not taken into account in the above indicator.

### Performance scenarios

The figures shown include all the costs of the product itself, but may not include all the costs you pay to your adviser or distributor. ## What happens if AISM Luxembourg S.A. is unable to pay out?

In the event of the insolvency of AISM Luxembourg S.A., the fund's assets, held in custody with the depositary bank, will be liquidated by the latter and the proceeds distributed to investors. The depositary bank is legally required to segregate its own assets from those of the fund. Therefore, in the event of the insolvency of the depositary bank, the risk of financial loss to the product is mitigated. No compensation scheme or investor guarantee system is in place to cover any losses.

## What are the costs?
